Information About ANF

The **Anti-Narcotics Force (ANF)** is a federal paramilitary agency of the Government of **Pakistan** responsible for combating narcotics smuggling, illegal drug trafficking and reducing drug demand and abuse across the country. It operates under the **Ministry of Interior and Narcotics Control**.

- **Established:** 21 February 1995 (by merging previous anti-narcotics organisations).
- **Headquarters:** Rawalpindi, Pakistan.
- **Type:** Federal executive bureau / paramilitary enforcement agency.
- **Motto:** *Drugs Free Pakistan*.
- **Director-General:** Currently a serving Major-General from Pakistan Army.

Main Roles & Responsibilities

1. Law Enforcement Against Drug Trafficking

ANF leads operations to stop smuggling of illegal drugs entering Pakistan — especially from Afghanistan and Iran — and then stops transport across borders or within the country.

This includes:

- Major seizures of heroin, hashish, methamphetamine (ice), opium, and other narcotics.
- Arresting traffickers and smugglers.
- Registering cases under the **Control of Narcotic Substances Act (1997)**.

Example: In recent nationwide operations, ANF has seized thousands of kilograms of drugs worth hundreds of millions of rupees and arrested numerous suspects.

2. Drug Supply Reduction

ANF carries out counter-narcotics missions — intercepting smuggling routes, raids, and law enforcement actions across Pakistan.

3. Drug Demand Reduction

Unlike many countries that separate enforcement and education, ANF also works to prevent drug abuse and reduce demand through awareness programs, rehabilitation referrals and community outreach.

4. Rehabilitation & Treatment

ANF runs a **Drug Treatment & Rehabilitation Centre** in Model Town Humak (Islamabad) that offers free medical and psychological care to drug addicts and supports long-term recovery.

- Patients receive professional treatment.
- The centre follows up with patients for up to two years.
- It has helped over 11,000 people recover.

5. International Cooperation

ANF cooperates with foreign law enforcement agencies and hosts **Drug Liaison Officers** from many countries to share information, improve operations and conduct controlled deliveries.

Organisational Structure

ANF has a central headquarters in Rawalpindi and regional directorates in major cities like Karachi, Lahore, Peshawar, Quetta and others. It also operates numerous police stations focused on drug enforcement throughout the country.

It works in cooperation with:

- Pakistan Army,
- Local police forces,
- Customs & border security,

- International partners (e.g., UN agencies).

Training & Capacity Building

ANF officials receive specialized training — including:

- Digital forensics,
- Handling new psychoactive substances,
- Crime scene investigation,
- Money laundering and terror financing related to drug crimes.

This training is often supported by international partners like the **UNDP** and the **U.S. Embassy's Office of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs**.

Mission & Vision

- **Mission:** Enforce strong actions against drug trafficking, reduce demand, promote international cooperation, and support rehabilitation — ultimately working toward a **drug-free Pakistan**.
- **Vision:** A healthier and more productive society free from illicit drugs and their harmful effects.

Public Support & Outreach

ANF encourages citizens to report drug-related activity and provides a confidential helpline for assistance.

Legal Framework

ANF works mainly under the **Control of Narcotic Substances Act, 1997 (CNS Act)**.

Major Legal Powers of ANF

ANF officers are legally empowered to:

1. **Search & Seizure**
 - ✚ Search persons, vehicles, ships, aircraft, and buildings suspected of drug activity
 - ✚ Seize narcotic drugs, chemicals, equipment, and assets
2. **Arrest Without Warrant**
 - ✚ Arrest suspects involved in possession, trafficking, manufacturing, or financing of narcotics
3. **Registration of FIRs**
 - ✚ Register cases under CNS Act directly (like police powers)
4. **Controlled Deliveries**
 - ✚ Allow drug consignments to move under surveillance to catch major traffickers
5. **Financial Investigation**
 - ✚ Investigate money laundering linked to drug trade
 - ✚ Freeze assets gained through narcotics
6. **Prosecution**
 - ✚ Present cases in **Special Narcotics Courts**
 - ✚ Officers act as complainants and witnesses
7. **Inter-Agency Coordination**
 - ✚ Work jointly with Police, FIA, Customs, Coast Guards, Rangers, and Armed Forces
